



Leadership Identification and Development

Committee appointed by the President. Minimum of five (5) members. (At least two (2) Past State Presidents, plus three (3) members from the general membership, also anyone currently serving at the National level).

Leadership Identification and Development is responsible for the identification, development and positioning of qualified members from the Local and State networks for leadership opportunities, ensuring that the organization has a strong talented cadre of members interested in developing their leadership skills.

Provide guidance to members wishing to obtain Volunteer involvement. Observe emerging leaders at State and Local events. Intentionally cultivate local presidents for future contribution at the State level. Encourage leaders to self-nominate for consideration of State and National volunteer involvement.

Identify and submit to National Women's Council the allocated number of recommendations for National volunteer opportunities for the following year by the date specified by National.

Once names are submitted to National Women's Council, Chair will contact each applicant on disposition of their application, whether or not submitted to Women's Council National. The Chair will offer any constructive advice to those not selected and encourage to consider submitting application next year.
